The University of Macedonia is located very near the city centre, located after the international fair of Thessaloniki and across the middle of Aristotle University campus. The transportation system can accommodate you merely from any hotel to the University. The bus numbers which can serve you from the centre are: 2,8,10,12,14,27,31.

Numbers 2 and 14 stop in front of the main entrance, numbers 10, 27 and 31 near the back entrance and the rest near a stop within short walking distance from the University.

The regular bus fares cost 1€ and discounted bus fares cost 0.50€. Pre-printed tickets may be purchased at OASTH (urban transportation service of Thessaloniki) ticket selling booths, or at ticket vending machines on-board buses. The trip tickets issued by ticket machines on-board buses cost 0.10€ more than their nominal value. More detailed information is available [here](#).

Taxis from the hotel areas to the University normally cost 4-6 Euros (daytime).

Transportation:

In order to reach the city centre from the airport there are two alternatives:

- By taxi (there is a waiting line outside the airport). It should normally cost you about 20-25 Euros. However, after midnight the tariff doubles.
- By bus - bus number 78, 78A or 78N (N is for Night), passing through the city centre. The connection is relatively frequent: approximately every 20 minutes in daytime and every 30 minutes at night after 23:00. You can get the ticket either from the booth next to the bus stop or from a machine inside the bus. (You should consult the map of the transportation lines first)
